1. Create Content

1. Create interactive videos with quiz and short answer responses.

Any video on ClickView can be turned into an interactive video. You can set a wide range of different question types that will auto mark as well as short answer responses. When the students watch the interactive video it will automatically pause and they will need to answer the question before they can go on.
