SERVICE DESCRIPTION

Microsoft Stream is an Enterprise level video service where people in your organization can upload, view, and share videos securely. You can share recordings of classes, meetings, presentations, training sessions, or other videos that aid your class' collaboration. Microsoft Stream also makes it easy to share comments on a video, tag timecodes in comments and descriptions to refer to specific points in a video and discuss with staff or students.

Microsoft Stream also helps you organize content into Channels and Groups so it's easier to find. Microsoft Stream works well with other Office 365 apps like Teams, SharePoint, OneNote, and Yammer, giving even more ways to discover more relevant content.

LEARNLINK ADMINISTRATION

What happens when you turn Stream on?

- Staff – Enables staff to upload and manage videos
- Students – Enables students to view videos added by staff (where permissions have been granted)

USE CASE - STAFF

Staff may wish to upload videos for discussion or as part of an assignment to a central location that all students can view and comment on.

Another use case would be a video embedded in Teams, SharePoint or another O365 service that is to be viewed and comment on that is ultimately stored in Stream.

USE CASE – STUDENTS

Students can consume content on Stream to help support their learning experience.

RISK CONSIDERATIONS

Stream data is stored in the South East Asia (Hong Kong and Singapore) data centers.

BANDWIDTH

Like any streaming service Stream uses adaptive streaming to adjust its bandwidth requirements to best utilise what is available.

SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITY

Requesting access to manage this service within the school environment means the school takes on responsibility for ensuring the users of this service within their site are trained appropriately, the service is used within standard DECD policies,
