Dear Parents/Caregivers,

The State Government has moved to Stage Three of the easing of Covid-19 Restrictions, this has implications for KICE and parents from Monday June 29th.

From June 29th

1. Parents may enter school and preschool grounds. We ask that parents still do not enter classrooms unless necessary as we are still bound by the following rules.

All adults must continue to follow the density and physical distancing guidelines outlined by SA Health:

- *no more than 1 person per 4-square metres in an enclosed space.*
- *maintain a minimum social distance of 1.5 metres.*

2. Assemblies will resume with limited parent attendance in term 3.

Chairs will be put out at assemblies in rows to comply with the distancing guidelines. All visitors to assemblies need to be seated. If there are no remaining chairs then this means we have reached the maximum number of parents for the space.

3. From term three, volunteers must obtain both teacher and Head of Campus permission before entering the buildings and they must complete the site access form on each visit to the school.
4. Excursions and interschool sports competitions will resume.
5. Playgroups will be returning to the Parndana Campus at the start of term 3.
6. KICE facilities will be again available for hire with restrictions. These restrictions can be fully explained when making/enquiring about a booking.

Thank you for continuing to support the 1.5 metre social distance rule when collecting children from school. We appreciate that parents are keeping children at home when they are unwell, please ensure that children have fully recovered before returning to school.

We are pleased that we are moving forward with the easing of restrictions and have valued the way parents have continued to work with us to ensure everyone's safety and wellbeing at this difficult time.

Take care and enjoy the upcoming school holiday break with our 2.20pm dismissal on Friday 3rd of July, and a reminder school resumes on Thursday July 23rd.
